When: Monday through Friday - Starting Monday June 25 through Friday August 3, 2018.

Summer Program will be closed on Wednesday July 4th in observation of Independence Day.

Hours: 9:15-2:00PM Monday – Thursday and 9:15-12:00PM on Fridays.

Activities: Weekly trips to Kingston or Pawtuckaway NH State Park, Leo’s SuperBowl and Hodgies, Daily Arts & Crafts, Wood Working, Pottery, Sports, Science in the Park Program, Hiking in Maudslay State Park.

Summer weekly trips in the past included: York’s Wild Kingdom York ME, New England Aquarium/IMAX, Pawtuckaway State Park, Hilltop Fun Center NH, and Candia NH Water Park.

July 9 – 11 program will be aboard a boat from the Captains Lady’s fleet and Merrohawke / Boat Camp Nature School floating classroom in Newburyport. Campers will need to bring:
